Ceco – grant for sound and lights \$1108 (Marilyn and Patti are exploring information-the cost has gone up since they asked us for wish items for the grant),

Chula Vista – \$7000 grant for storytelling (Money to pay the tellers) – David Schmidt.

Just received approval for full amount. Stories focused on Chula Vista, especially scary stories. David is writing a book about the local stories which will be given to schools in Chula Vista. 4 Schools and libraries programs. A culminating event in Procter Valley, in the monster's habitat, including a nature walk. September and October.

Storytelling in Schools from SAC - \$1950 (Money to pay the tellers) for storytelling in Chula Vista – David Schmidt, approved funding- 6 schools. David is open to ideas and looking for contacts. He will put the word out as to who might be interested in telling. Please contact him in the next two weeks. Programs in the schools will be during the day, library or museum events may be evening or weekend times.

City of Encinitas – we received \$2790 for 2024-2025 storytelling schools, senior facilities, civic organizations (It is important that we find ways to spend this year's money-about \$500 more left to spend, otherwise we may need to return it to the city. Marilyn just booked 3 shows in senior facilities. Any ideas can be brought forward to Marilyn, moving into next year ideas.
